PhD scholarship grants 2025

The *African German Centre for Food Systems and Data Science* offers scholarships to support a **PhD-Thesis research projects in southern Africa** in cooperation with one of our partner institutions. The scholarships are funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) with funds from the Federal Ministry of Research, Technology and Space (BMFTR), Germany.

- The primary aim of UKUDLA is to develop young scientists' expertise in sustainable and resilient food systems and applied data science. Applications from disciplines that integrate both themes are particularly encouraged.
- **The scholarship covers a time period of 36 months (+ 6 months optional extension)** with subsistence allowance (e.g. 1.800,00 Euro/month for South Africa). **Travel/ flight costs are provided** and **additional research funds** can be applied for.
- **Applications can be submitted until 1st July 2025.**
